What types of patients are candidates? What kinds of procedures can I perform while you are sedating my patients?

We can safely administer sedation/general anesthesia to any relatively healthy child or adult. You can do just about any type of procedure from a simple extraction to a full-mouth restoration. Remember, if our doctors are not in the dental office, they are in a hospital OR administering anesthesia on patients who receive all types of procedures.

How much is it to use your service?

For the dental office, there is no fee - ever. For your qualifying patient, the cost will be significantly less than visiting a hospital to receive anesthesia, as our office based service does not carry extra hospital fees that can usually increase costs.

How convenient is it?

You will work uninterrupted. You will be in your own familiar surroundings and your patient will be deeply sedated or under a general anesthetic. It will be easy to perform cases that might have taken multiple appointments.

Why is your service so safe?

Every potential patient is evaluated by a member of our staff before obtaining clearance for surgery. Each case is performed by a board-certified anesthesiologist along with a certified nurse. We are a 100% mobile company and bring to your dental practice the level of care you'd expect in the hospital.
